



# **ACTION FROM 1<sup>ST</sup> DECEMBER 2011**

The CEC considered what action might be appropriate to engage in beyond 30<sup>th</sup> November and has agreed on a rolling programme of action which will escalate if insufficient progress has been made. The first phase of that action will commence on 1<sup>st</sup> December and the CEC advises:

## **NO UTU MEMBER SHOULD CO-OPERATE WITH SCHOOL INSPECTORS.**

This will include non-involvement in scheduled inspections, non-cooperation with school inspectors who visit the school for any purpose and no communication of data of any kind to the ETI.

## **UTU WILL BE INFORMING THE ETI THAT THIS ACTION IS TO TAKE PLACE.**

**PLEASE INFORM MEMBERS THAT THE BALLOT PROTECTS TEACHERS TAKING ACTION OF THIS KIND IN SUPPORT OF A TRADE DISPUTE AND THAT THEY CANNOT IN ANY WAY BE DISCIPLINED DURING THE PERIOD COVERED BY THE BALLOT.**

**EXEMPTION:** The CEC has agreed that any school currently in a programme of Intervention following a School Inspection will be exempt from this action.
